Sludge



Collective sludge

France: sludge from sewage, tonnes dredging of ditches, rivers and Animal waste 94 % of all agricultural manuring.

Individual sludge

15 to 20 kg per person per year of sludge (dry matter). 60% of the tonnage of dry matter is used in farm manuring.

Nitrogen

Nitrogen (periodic symbol N) changes its chemical composition very easily, through association with oxygen or hydrogen molecules. Nitrogen and hydrogen form ammonia (NH4). Nitrogen, by consuming oxygen, forms nitrates (NO2 or NO3).

Phosphorus Nitrogen and phosphorus are the basic ingredients of fertilisers.

Ammonia 95% of ammonia emissions come from agriculture, of which 80%

come from livestock farming.

89% of cadmium contamination of French soil is caused by fertilisers.

69% of zinc contamination of French soil is caused by pig
